The principles of design are the building blocks used to create a work of art. Each week we will focus on two!

Week 1: Unity and variety

July 25-29

Unity is when everything looks like it belongs together. **Variety** is just the opposite. It shakes things up to create interest. Just like us! Some of us want to blend in and others want to stand out!

Activities will include: abstract designs, shape tessellations, painting with warm and cool colors, and nature collage with guest artist, Cheryl O'Loughlin.

Week 2: Repetition and movement

August 1-5

The root of **repetition** is the word "repeat." When you repeat a certain size, or shape or color you add strength to the overall image. Repeating elements can also create **movement** and rhythm. **Projects will include:** weaving, swirly painting like Van Gogh, op-art, Betty Gold-inspired cut-outs, and collage with guest artist: Gerald Mead

Theatre in the afternoon!

Each week we will incorporate the theme, "principles of design," into our afternoons of theatre fun. Activities will include: skits, storytelling, theatre games, scenes, costumes, make-up and more! Actors from NURT (Niagara University Repertory Theatre) will visit each week to perform for campers and offer instruction.

Week 3: Scale and proportion

August 8-12

Scale is the size relation of one thing to another, like when you put something really big next to something small. **Proportion** is the relationship of the parts to a whole, like what size your eyes and nose are in relationship to the size of your head. **Activities will include:** Scanga-inspired figures, self-portraits, really big flower paintings, and Oldenberg-like sculpture with guest artist Karen Abbo.

Week 4: Balance – Symmetrical and A-symmetrical

August 15-19

Balance is how to make two sides of an artwork look equal. **Symmetrical** balance is exactly the same on both sides. In **a-symmetrical** balance, the two sides feel the same but are not exactly the same. **Projects include:** Picasso faces, pointillism butterflies, Pop Art prints, and water-color landscapes with guest artist: Kath Schifano
